

Revelation 19

The Judgments of God

1 After these things I heard a great voice of a vast throng in heaven, saying, “Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power unto the Lord our God,

2 For true and righteous are His judgments, for He has judged the great whore (Babylon) who corrupts the earth with her fornication, and has avenged the blood of His servants at her hand.”

Those who have capitulated to the One World Religion who persecuted and martyred the saints of God, must reap what they have sown.

3 And again they said, “Hallelujah!” And her (Babylon’s) smoke rose up for the eons of the eons.

The “smoke of her torment” signifies her reaping what she has sown and her purification by spiritual fire. This will take place for the “eons of the eons” - the last two eons.

Let’s have a short study on the words *eon* and *eonian*. It is obvious that the translators did not understand the word “*eon*” so they translated it in many ways: eternal, everlasting, eternity, and forever. But none of these words are ever found in the Bible in the original Scriptures.

The words are always either eon or eonian.

We know that the word eon refers to a specific period of time with a beginning and an end because in several Bible passages, it speaks of the end, or conclusion, of the eon or eons. Well, we know that “eternity” never ends, so therefore, we know that the word eon CANNOT mean eternity or eternal or everlasting or forever!

Hebrews 9:26 “end of the eons” mistranslated “end of the world.”

1 Cor 10:11 “ends of the eons” mistranslated “ends of the world.”

Matthew 24:3 “end of the eons” mistranslated “end of the world.”

The Bible also talks about future eons:

Direct Literal
Translation -
Concordant
Bible

vs 3 Grace to you and peace from God, our Father, and the

vs 4 Lord Jesus Christ, Who gives Himself for our sins, so that He might extricate us out of the **present wicked**

vs 5 **eon**, according to the will of our God and Father, to Whom be glory for the **eons of the eons**. Amen!

There are FIVE Eons of “time” in earth’s history:

- 1) From the time the earth was created until humanity was created
- 2) From the time humanity was created until the flood (about 1,500 years)
- 3) From the flood until Jesus’ 2nd coming (about 4,500 years)
- 4) From Jesus’ 2nd coming until the Judgment (1,000 years – the Millennium)
- 5) From the Judgment until we enter eternity (possibly 1,000 years)

From Creation of humanity until Jesus 2nd coming: $1,500 + 4,500 = 6,000$ years


From Jesus 2nd coming until we enter eternity: $1,000 + 1,000? = 2,000$ years

So, from the Creation of humanity until we enter eternity = 8,000 years

The number “8” in the Bible means “New Beginning.”

These FIVE eons of “time” are also symbolized by the Sanctuary in the wilderness:

- 1) Outside the camp (where the scapegoat – representing Satan – was taken)
- 2) Inside the camp (where the Israelites lived in their tents)
- 3) Inside the temple court (where the Israelites brought their sacrifices)
- 4) The Holy Place (where the priests offered the sacrifices to God)
- 5) The Most Holy Place (where God’s presence resided on the ark – that contained only ONE thing: the Ten Commandments)



4 And the twenty-four elders and the four beasts (animals) fall and worship God, who is sitting on the throne, saying, “Amen Hallelujah!”

5 And a voice came out from the throne, saying “Praise our God, all His servants, and those who fear (reverence) Him, both small and the great.”

Many theologians believe that the twenty-four elders are human beings who were resurrected at the time of Christ and went to heaven with him.

The four beasts, or living creatures, are spoken of in Revelation 4:6,7;

“And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four animals (beasts - living creatures) full of eyes in front and behind.

“And the first creature was like a lion (representing wild animals), and the second beast like a calf (representing domesticated animals), and the third beast had a face as a man (representing humanity), and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle (representing the birds of the air).”

These four “living creatures” represents ALL of creation, except for the fish. More specifically, it represents ALL of creation that was destroyed by the flood (with the exception of those who were in the ark). The fish were not destroyed in the flood.

6 And I hear as it were the voice of a great multitude, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, “Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the omnipotent (Almighty), reigns!

7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His bride (those who are righteous) has made herself ready.”

8 And to her it was granted that she may be clothed in fine linen (representing the righteousness of God’s people), clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of the saints.

9 And he says to me, “Write: Blessed are they who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb.” And he says to me, “These are the true sayings of God.”

10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said to me, “See that thou do it not: I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”

In Revelation 1:9, John tells us why he has been exiled to the lonely, remote Isle of Patmos:

“I, John, your brother and joint participant in the affliction and kingdom and endurance in Jesus Christ, **came be in the island called Patmos**, because of the Word of God (John’s belief in the prophecies Old Testament pointing forward to Christ’s first coming) **and because of the testimony of Jesus Christ**” (John’s belief in the life of Jesus - or what eventually became known as the Gospels).

John tells us that the testimony of Jesus (the testimony that Jesus exhibited by His perfect life) IS “the spirit of prophecy.” And John tells us he was exiled to Patmos because of this “testimony of Jesus.”

It is clear that the ONLY thing that can be designated as the “Spirit of Prophecy” is the Life of Jesus when He was on earth!

11 And I saw heaven open and Behold, a white horse, and He that sat upon it was called “Faithful and True” (obviously, this represents Christ) and in righteousness judges and makes war (spiritual war: trials and temptations that lead to spiritual purification).

12 Now His eyes are a flame of fire (He will purify ALL mankind with spiritual fire - His fiery law (Deuteronomy 33:2) and on His head are many crowns (He is the king of ALL creation in the universe), and He had a name written (name: describes character) that no man knew, but He himself.

13 And He was clothed with a vesture (cloak) dipped in blood (representing His crucifixion), and His name is called “The Word of God.” (Jesus is described as the “Word” in John 1:1-3, 14).

14 And the armies in heaven, followed Him on white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of His mouth a sharp sword (truth) is issuing, that with it He should smite (purifying) the nations (unbelievers). And He shall be shepherding them with a rod of iron. (purification - by God who does it all by controlling the circumstances of our life and bringing us through trials and temptations we need to learn to become like Him).

What does “rod of iron” mean? Most people associate it with aggression and punishment, but a “rod of iron” in the Bible does not mean “war” or punishment – it was a device used by a shepherd tending sheep.

In the 23rd Psalm, King David said:

“Thy rod and thy staff, they COMFORT me.” Psalm 23:4

The shepherd’s “staff” has a crook on the top of it, to fit around the sheep’s neck to gently bring the wandering sheep back into the sheepfold.



The “rod” was used to fight off predators who came after the sheep.

When the Bible says, “Spare the rod – and spoil the child,” it doesn’t mean that children need to be disciplined by beating them. It means that a parent should protect them from evil and discipline them properly to “bring them back to the fold.”

As the Bible says, “Judgment returns (turns us back to) righteousness (right-doing).
Psalms 94:15

THAT is What Happens at the Judgment! God allows us to Reap what we have sown, in order to bring us back to Him - - - NOT to destroy us.

Jesus said:

s Luke 9:56

Jesus refers to Himself as the Good Shepherd and WE are His “sheep.” HE is the One who “shepherds” us back into His fold.

When David said, “Thy rod and Thy staff, they COMFORT me”, he meant that He was at peace because He was “SAFE in the arms of Jesus.” He knew that God was running his life!

And He is treading the wine trough of the fury of the indignation of the Almighty God (God’s wrath is demonstrated by His giving us up to our own desires - letting us have our own way to reap what we have sown).

16 And on His vesture (cloak) and on His thigh He has a name written: King of kings and Lord of lords.”

17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun. And he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, “Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God!

18 That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses and of those sitting on them, and the flesh of ALL men, both free and bond, and both small and of great.”

The scavengers of the air (“birds”) are called on to “eat the flesh” of ALL who still have “flesh.” The act of circumcision symbolized the “cutting off of the flesh”, meaning overcoming the “flesh” (the carnal nature of man) and becoming spiritual - becoming a new creation in Christ - being “born again” (proper translation, being “born from above”)!

This passage tells us that the “birds” are called on by God to “eat the flesh” of ALL the wicked which represents the eventual purification of ALL sinners!

19 And I saw the beast (First beast of Revelation 13 - The New World Order political power - Jewish Illuminati “fronted” by the United Nations) and the kings of the earth (the Ten Kings of the Ten Kingdoms of the New World Order that receive their power from the “Beast” - Jewish Illuminati), and their armies, gathered to make war against Him that sat on the horse and against His army. (This clearly is the Battle of Armageddon - a Spiritual battle between Satan and his followers versus Christ and His true followers).

20 And the beast was taken (the destruction of the One World Government), and with him the false prophet (the One World Religion – the worship of Satan) that wrought miracles before him (in the beast’s presence) presence (meaning that those following the false religion are doing the bidding of the (political) Beast - Jewish Illuminati/One World Government) by which he deceived those that had received the mark (developed the character – followed after) of the beast, and those that worshiped its image (those who develop a character - or image - of the beast - which is Jewish Illuminati Zionism – meaning those who join with the Jewish Zionists and Christian Zionists – who believe the Jews have the right to rule the world and make slaves of everyone else).

These both were cast alive into a lake of fire (spiritual purification with God’s “fiery” law) burning with brimstone (divine fire).

Brimstone – the Greek word *theion*, means **divine**. “Fire and Brimstone” means **divine fire** – God’s divine fire that purifies us from sin.

They were cast into the divine fire of God for purification of their sin. This is clearly NOT a literal fire as we can see from Revelation 20:14 where it says

“And death and hell (literally - the grave) were cast into the lake of fire.”

It is IMPOSSIBLE to cast “death and the grave) into a LITERAL lake of fire!

21 And the remnant were slain (the “old man of sin” was destroyed) with the sword (of Truth) of Him who sat upon the horse (Christ). And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

The “flesh” of ALL the wicked was devoured by their reaping what they have sown and by learning the truth of Jesus Christ! After they are purified, God says He will become “ALL in ALL.” (1 Corinthians 15:28)

God promises:

“Behold, I make ALL new.” Revelation 21:5
